### All Major Work Completed For The Church Avenue Reconstruction Project:

The NYC Department of Design and Construction (NYCDDC) has completed all major work operations for the Church Avenue Reconstruction Project HWKP2026.

**Remaining Work:** There is still some remaining work to be completed, which includes, but, not limited to: planting of trees and punch list items.

On that note, the DDC would like to thank the Elected Officials, Community Boards 14 and 17 and the community at large for being patient while we improved the infrastructure of this area.

### Work operations for this project included the installation of:

- Water Main (12") - 1,529 linear feet
- Sewer (15") - 947 linear feet
- Manholes - 12
- Catch Basins - 22
- Chute Connections - 558 linear feet
- Curbs - 3,174 linear feet
- Pigmented Sidewalk - 15,500 square feet
- Non-Pigmented Sidewalk - 27,233 square feet
- Roadway Asphalt Paving
- Milled and Paved Flatbush Avenue and Church Avenue and Bedford Avenue and Church Avenue Intersections
