## Rain Garden Maintainer

The Department of Environmental Protection, in partnership with various City agencies, constructs rain gardens for the purpose of stormwater capture and improved water quality of NYC waterways. Rain gardens combine engineered stormwater capture with the natural elements of soils and plants, and require particular and specialized care and maintenance. The majority of rain gardens are sited in Brooklyn, Queens and the Bronx. DEP is responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of these green infrastructure systems.

As **Seasonal City Park Workers**, the selected candidates will:

- Assist in general maintenance work, including edging, seeding, snow removal, cultivating, fertilizing, trimming, sweeping, removal of sediments and raking of litter
- Clean and maintain facilities including drainage structures
- Drive vehicles and operate certain other motorized equipment

Valid NYS Driver's license is required and must be maintained for the duration of employment.

**Salary: \$16.14 p/hr.—40 hr. work week**



**Rain gardens** are planted areas designed to collect and manage stormwater that runs off the streets and sidewalks when it rains.
