The NYC Dept. of Design and Construction (DDC) continue work operations for the Church Avenue Reconstruction Project HWKP2027 on Church Avenue from Coney Island Avenue to Flatbush Avenue. The project is scheduled for completion in Fall 2018.

Work operations for this project include the:
Installation of:

- Pedestrian Wayfinding Signage; Water Mains, Catch Basins, Manholes.
- Planting of New Trees.
- Replacement of Sidewalks and Curb
- Milling and Paving of Roadway

Work In Progress – installation of:

McDonald Avenue and Church Avenue Intersection:

- Test pits

Within Project Limits:

- Catch Basins and Chute Connections
- Water mains
- Sidewalk and Curbs
- Incidental work

Water Service Interruptions

During the course of the project there will be service interruptions. To allow water main replacement, the existing water service must be shut off by closing the valves at either end of the section. Advance notice will be given for all planned interruptions. Water service will be restored at the end the work day.

Special Needs

The DDC staff will work specifically with individuals that have special needs who may be uniquely impacted by the project. Please reach out to the project's Community Construction Liaison, as soon as possible, to make them aware of your situation. DDC will work with you to attempt to minimize the inconvenience as much as possible.

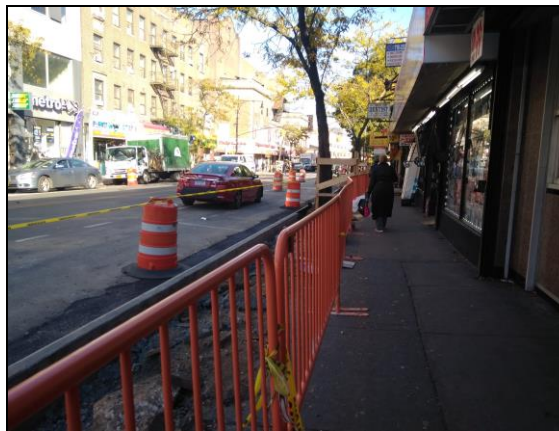
Property Damage

You are advised to inform the DDC or the Contractor of any of your property damage that you may have. If the contractor fails to respond within 10 days, you should inform the DDC Borough Director in writing. If you intend to file a claim you must do so within 90 days of the occurrence with the New York.

Community Impacts:

During construction hours, you can expect the following:

- Increased levels of dust, noise and heavy equipment.
- Vehicular travel lane closures will be required, as well as detours. Warning signs will be posted in advance.
- Parking and driveway/loading dock restrictions, signs will be posted within the affected areas.
- Emergency vehicle access and pedestrian access to sidewalk and buildings will be maintained at all times.
