Dear Community Resident:

Brooklyn Community Board 14 is pleased to announce that Department of Sanitation has approved the Board's plan for **additional** Sanitation collection services in portions of the Flatbush, Midwood and Kensington to assist our residents in preparation for Passover observances, which commence at sundown on Friday, April 19, 2019.

REFUSE:

Please refer to the map on the back of this notice.

There will be an extra day of collection – either Thursday, April 18th or Friday, April 19th – depending on your block's regular collection days. If your additional collection day is Friday, April 19th please note that all refuse materials, including chometz, **MUST** be placed at curbside, no later than 11:00 am on Friday April 19th to guarantee collection before midnight.

RECYCLING:

In these special collection zones, there will also be an additional midnight recycling collection on Friday, April 19th beginning at midnight. All recycling materials must be placed at curbside on the evening of Thursday, April 18th for collection on Friday, April 19th from 12:00 midnight to 8:00 am.

SPECIAL COLLECTION:

The Department of Sanitation requires appointments for removal of refrigerators, water coolers and air conditioners. Appointments must also be made for all electronics such as televisions, and computers, which will be collected on the Friday after you schedule. Call 311 or visit www.nyc.gov/sanitation to make these collection appointments. In order to ensure pick-up before the holiday, it is suggested that schedule prior to April 13th. It is important to prepare early and utilize sanitation services the week before the holiday for bulk items in order to avoid an excessive volume of debris that could impede planned schedules. *All mattresses placed out for collection must be sealed in plastic. Failure to do so will result in a summons.*

Special thanks to the Department of Sanitation Brooklyn South Borough Superintendent Andrew Pugliese, Deputy Chief Richard Ferraro, District 14 Superintendent Joseph Sciulara, as well as our local elected officials for their assistance in developing the plan.
