Assault rifle or ghost gun  
Handgun  
  
Rifle or shotgun  
  
Non-working, replica,  
antique, homemade or  
3D printed gun

**You get:**

\$500  
\$500 for first,  
then \$150 each  
  
\$75  
  
\$25

*Payment subject to approval and made via pre-paid gift card*

**How do I bring a gun to the drop off site?**

Guns must be UNLOADED and placed  
in a plastic bag, a paper bag, or a box.

**Can I transport the firearm in a car?**

Yes, it must be UNLOADED and in the trunk  
in a plastic bag, a paper bag, or a box.

**How many firearms can I surrender?**

As many as you wish to provide.

**Can any member of the public surrender a gun?**

Licensed gun dealers, and active or retired law  
enforcement officers are not eligible for this program.

**Do I need any identification to turn in a firearm?**

No, this is an Amnesty program, and no questions  
are asked of the person dropping off the firearm.

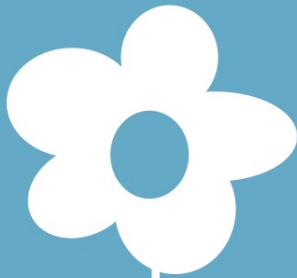

# Interactive Environmental STEM Workshops for Kids

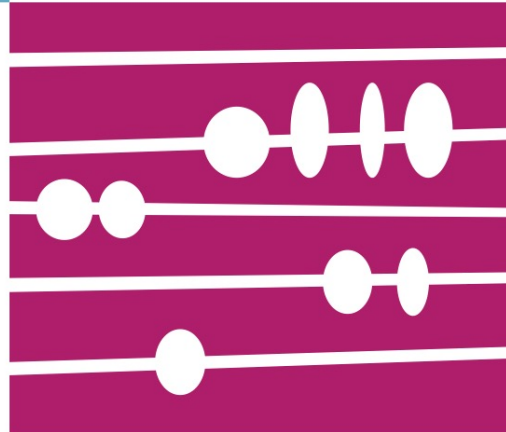
