

How do I bring a gun to the drop off site? Guns must be UNLOADED and placed in a plastic bag, a paper bag, or a box.

Can I transport the firearm in a car? Yes, it must be UNLOADED and in the trunk in a plastic bag, a paper bag, or a box.

How many firearms can I surrender? As many as you wish to provide.

Can any member of the public surrender a gun? Licensed gun dealers, and active or retired law enforcement officers are not eligible for this program.

Do I need any identification to turn in a firearm? No, this is an Amnesty program, and no questions are asked of the person dropping off the firearm. IN COLLABORATION WITH


Interactive Environmental STEM Workshops for Kids
