

Accessibility Upgrades at Church Avenue Q Station

Overview:

MTA Construction & Development (MTA C&D) is moving forward with station accessibility improvements at the Church Avenue Station. As part of a wider ADA program across the MTA, Church Avenue Station will receive:

- (2) New Street to Platform Elevators
- (2) New Stairways
- New Control Area
- ADA compliance upgrades to existing boarding areas, platform edges, sidewalks and stairways
- Agent booth upgrades

Project Benefits:

- Increased accessibility for riders of all mobility levels
- Improved travel experience due to new access routes and improved commuter flow
- Moderninzed design and improved visibility with new elevator enclosures, new control area, and other architectural improvements
- Enhanced safety due to new platform edges

Project Phases:

Phase I: Mobilization and Platform Work

This phase will include establishment of maintenance and protection of traffic plans, demolition, and other platform work.

Phase II: Elevator Installations and New Control Area

This will include installation of the new elevators, new control area, related architectural and structural work, culminating with commissioning and de-mobilization.
