



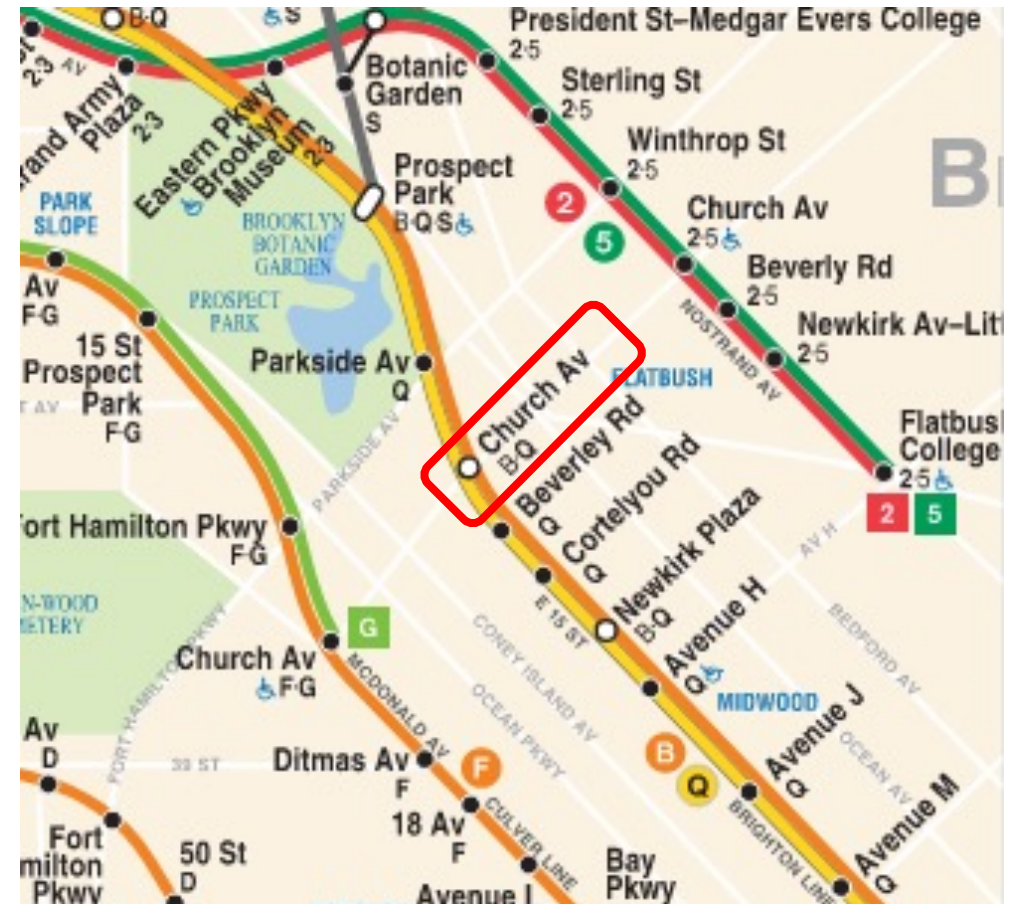
# Accessibility Upgrades at Church Ave Station

# Project Intent

- ADA Accessibility – part of a larger project at 13 stations throughout NYC
- Increased ADA Accessibility within NYCT infrastructure
- MTA's first Public-Private-Partnership project where the developer will design, build, and maintain the installed elevators for 25 years.
- Design-build contract awarded: May 2023
- Completion (this station): Q3 2025

# Customer Benefits – ADA Scope



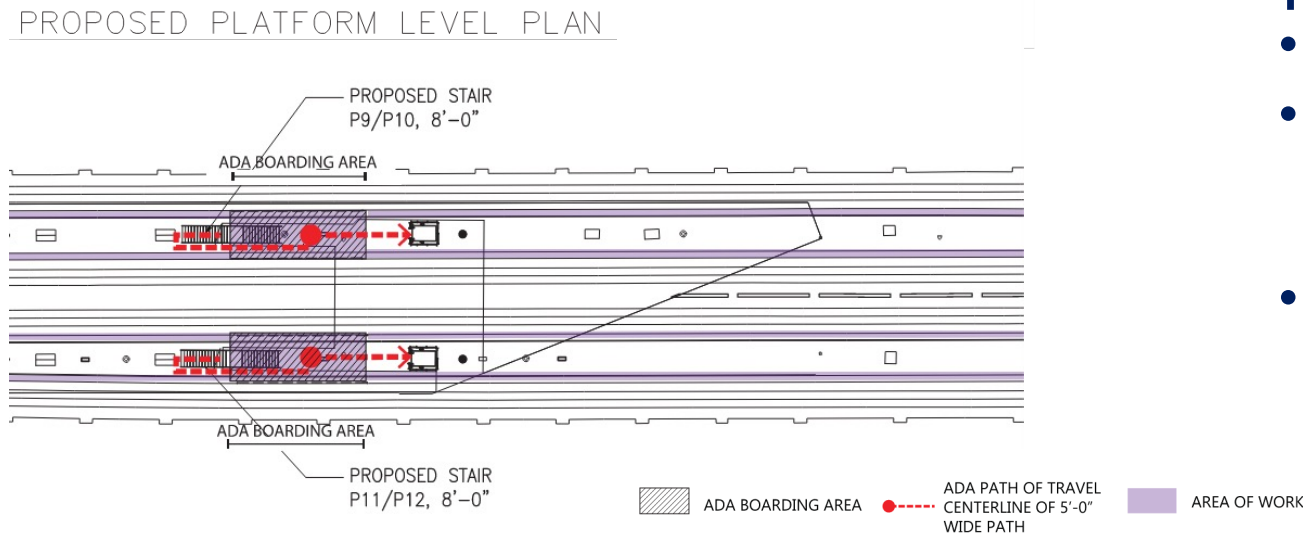
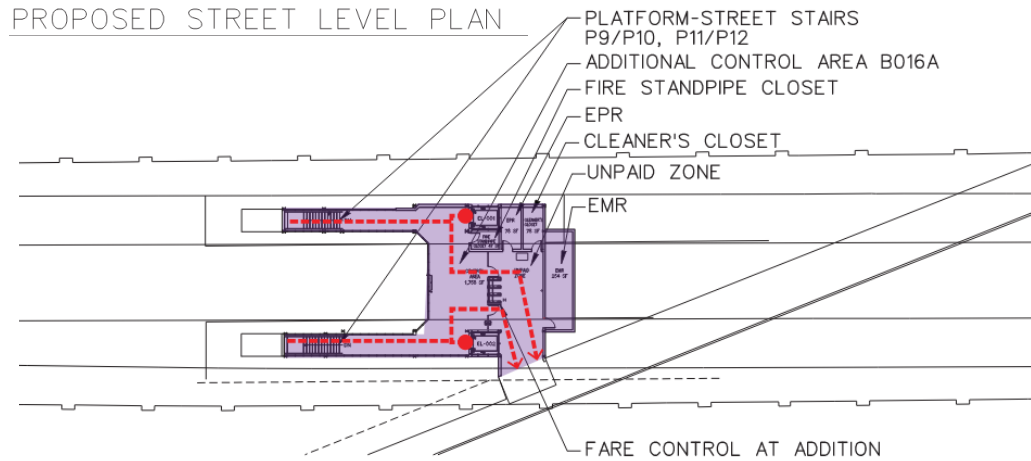
Rendering of upgraded Church Ave station entrance.



Improved access to the open-cut station through:

- (2) New elevators (1 each from street to platform level going North/South bound)
- (2) New stairs
- New Control Area
- Raised ADA boarding areas
- ADA compliant sidewalk curbs
- ADA compliant stairs
- Agent booth modifications

# Customer Benefits – General Scope



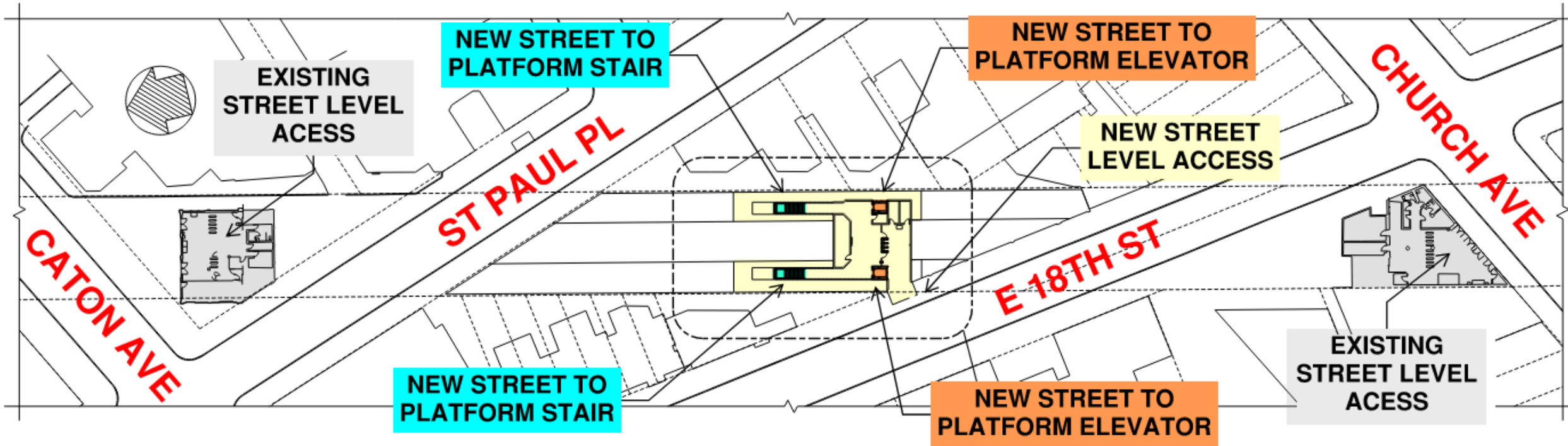
- Enhanced customer flow
  - New control area with street level access
  - New additional stairs
  - New elevators
- New Station Extensions with Updated MTA Standard Features
  - Enhanced station reliability
  - New and upgraded communications, electrical and MEP systems to support ADA upgrades
  - Improved Safety due to new platform edges.

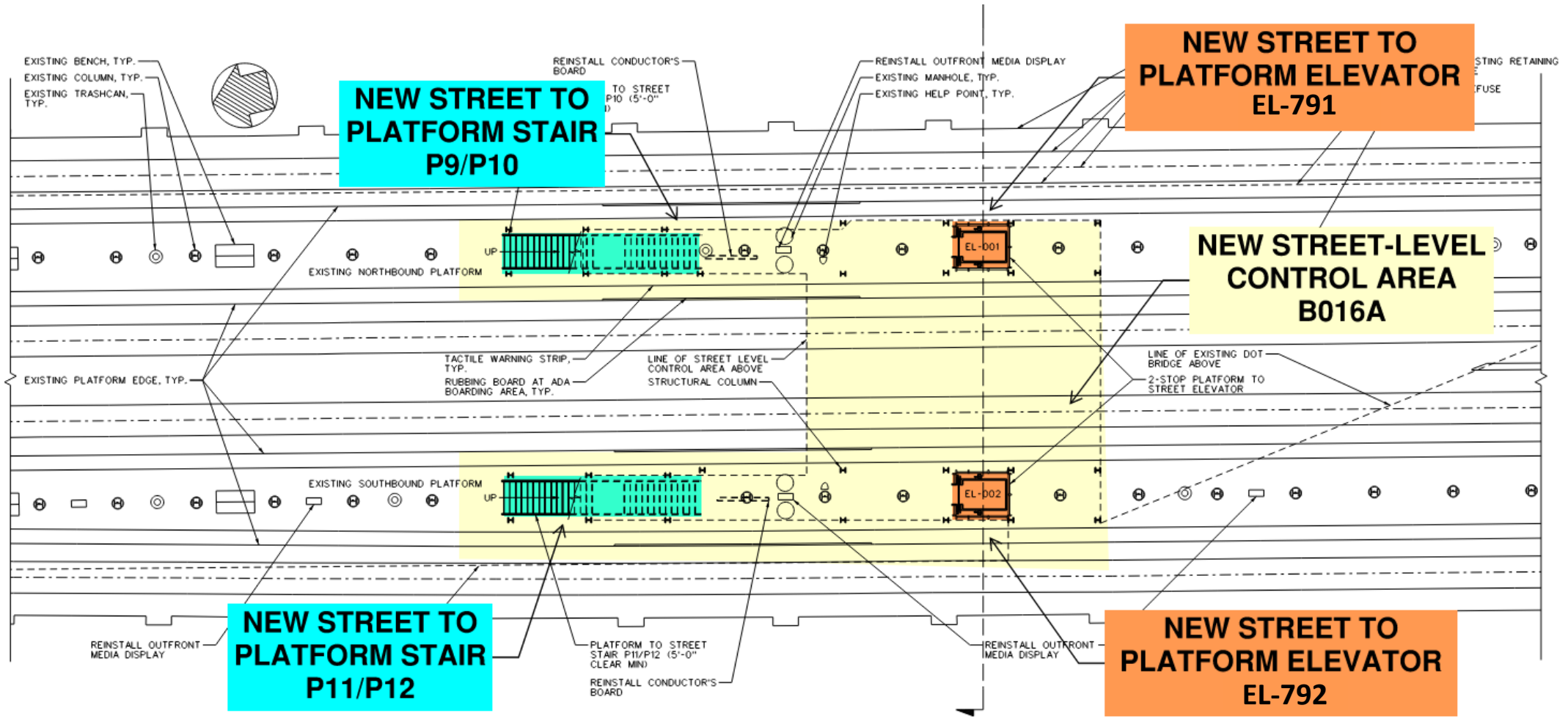
- Structural Concrete Work

# SERVICE OUTAGES
