- Are ages 40 and over
- Have not had a mammogram in the past year
- Have no signs or symptoms of breast disease
- Are insured, underinsured, or uninsured




**On the day of your appointment, bring:**

- Identification
- Health insurance card (if applicable)
- Copies of past mammograms

**Eligibility Criteria:**  
**Self-referred women must be 40-85 years old**

- Women **40 and older** can self-refer for an annual exam (12 months since prior mammogram)
- Women **cannot** be pregnant
- Women **cannot** be breastfeeding – we ask that women wait until they stop breastfeeding and breasts have returned to normal size
- Bra size **cannot** exceed 44 DD
- Women **cannot** have implants
- Women who have received their second COVID vaccination or booster less than 4 weeks prior to this appointment cannot be seen (mammogram is recommended first, followed by the booster).

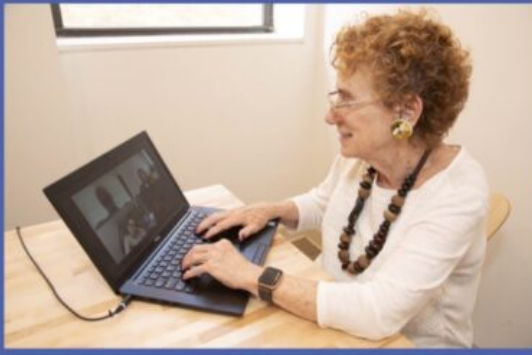
