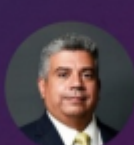

## BROOKLYN, QUEENS, AND STATEN ISLAND

In order to be eligible for up to \$1,000 per month, you must:

- Be 18 years old or older
- Be 23 weeks pregnant or less with your first child
- Live in one of the following neighborhoods:
  - **Central Brooklyn:** Bed-Stuy, Brownsville, Bushwick, Crown Heights, Canarsie, East Flatbush, East New York, Flatbush
  - **Queens:** Astoria, Corona, Elmhurst, Flushing, Jackson Heights, Jamaica
  - **Staten Island:** North Shore
- Have an annual household income under \$52K

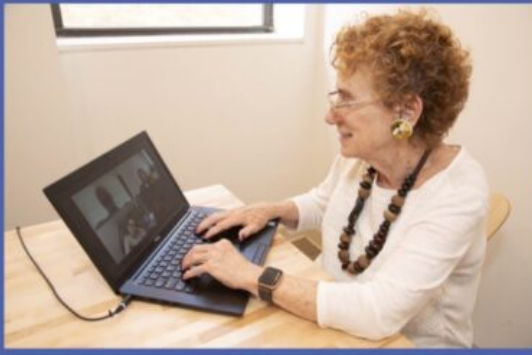
