OFFICIAL NOTICE

ATTENTION property owners and managers: Beginning **November 12, 2024**, all trash must be set out in a bin **(55 gallons or less)** with a secure lid.

This applies to:

- single-family homes
- two-family homes
- buildings with up to 9 apartments

You can use a compliant bin (55 gallons or less with a secure lid) that you already have, but starting June 2026, you **MUST** use an **Official NYC Bin**.

The Official NYC Bin is durable, rat resistant, and **costs less than \$50** for the most-used size! **Order by October 1** to ensure delivery by **November 12!**

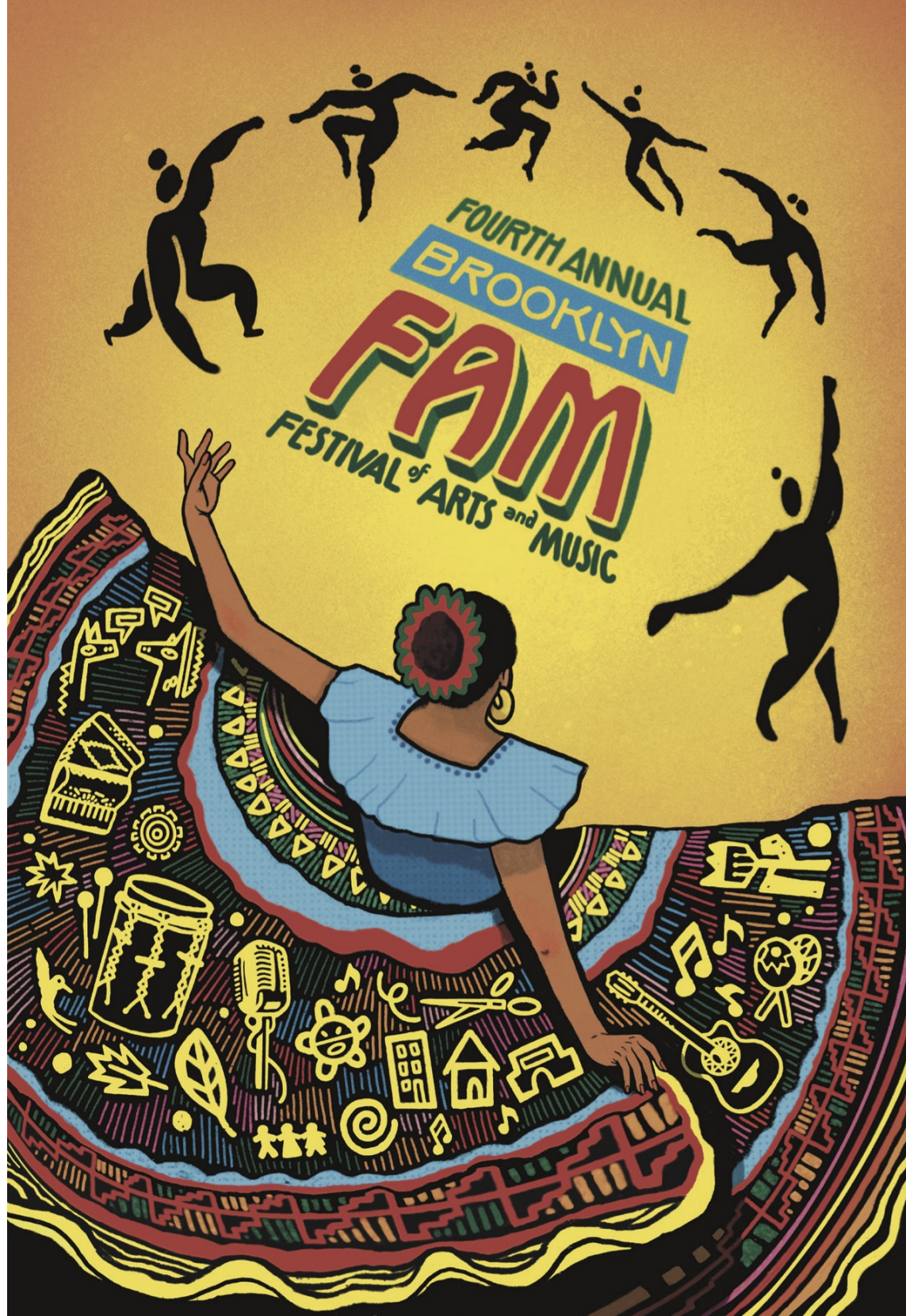

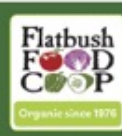

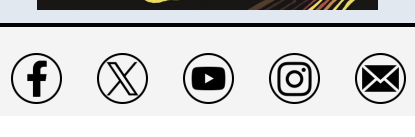
