The New York City Department of Sanitation announced that in observance of New Year's Day, Wednesday, January 1, 2025, there will be NO trash, curbside composting nor recycling collection on the holiday.

### CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION

Thanks to the expansion of curbside composting collection, all residents of Brooklyn can simply place their **Christmas tree and natural wreaths** out, with their food scraps and yard waste, for collection on their regularly scheduled compost and recycling day. After collection, the Christmas trees and wreaths will be turned in to finished compost or renewable energy.

Remember to remove all stands, tinsel, lights and ornaments before putting trees or wreaths out for collection. **Do NOT wrap trees in plastic bags**.

Need to get rid of an artificial tree? Residents looking to get rid of an artificial tree should separate and remove the metal base and trunk and place those parts with their other metal recycling, and set the tree as garbage on a regular trash collection day.
