Brooklyn Community Board 14 is pleased to announce that Department of Sanitation Commissioner Gregory Anderson has approved additional Sanitation collection services in portions of the district to assist residents in preparation for Passover observances, which commence at sundown on Wednesday, April 1, 2026.

REFUSE: Please refer to the map on the back of this notice. There will be an extra day of collection depending on your block's regular collection days. For areas with regular collection on Wednesday/Saturday, there will be an extra pick up on Tuesday, March 31. For areas with regular collection on Monday/Thursday and Tuesday/Friday, there will be an extra pick up on Wednesday, April 1. Please note that all refuse materials, including chometz, **MUST** be placed at curbside, no later than 9:00 am on Wednesday, April 1

RECYCLING: In these special collection zones, there will also be an additional recycling collection on Wednesday, April 1 beginning at midnight. All recycling materials must be placed at curbside on the evening of Tuesday, March 31 for collection on Wednesday, April 1 from 12:00 midnight to 8:00 am.

BULK: The Department of Sanitation requires appointments for removal of refrigerators, water coolers and air conditioners. Call 311 or visit www.nyc.gov/sanitation to make these collection appointments. In order to ensure pickup before the holiday, it is suggested that residents schedule pickups for appliances by Monday, March 30. It is important to prepare early and utilize sanitation services the week before the holiday for bulk items to avoid an excessive volume of debris that could impede planned schedules. All mattresses placed out for collection must be sealed in plastic; failure to do so will result in a summons.

Special thanks to the Department of Sanitation Brooklyn South Borough Assistant Chief Joseph O'Keefe, Brooklyn South Deputy Chief Nick Matuszewicz, BK 14 Superintendent Robert McKenna, and BK14 Supervisor Matt Nickel, as well as our local elected officials for their assistance in developing this plan.


