NYC BIN REQUIREMENT TAKES EFFECT IN JUNE 2026

Starting **June 2026**, NYC residents will be required to use the **official NYC Bin** for trash set-out as part of the City's residential containerization rules. Failure to use a NYC bin with a secure lid for trash setout may result in fines.

The NYC Bin is a standardized container designed for curbside collection. Using the bin helps keep sidewalks cleaner, reduce pests, and improve waste collection.

Reimbursement Program

A limited reimbursement program is available to help eligible residents offset the cost of purchasing an NYC Bin. Details on eligibility and how to apply are available at the link below.

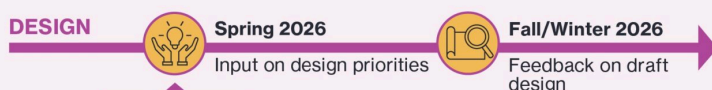

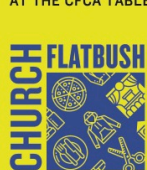

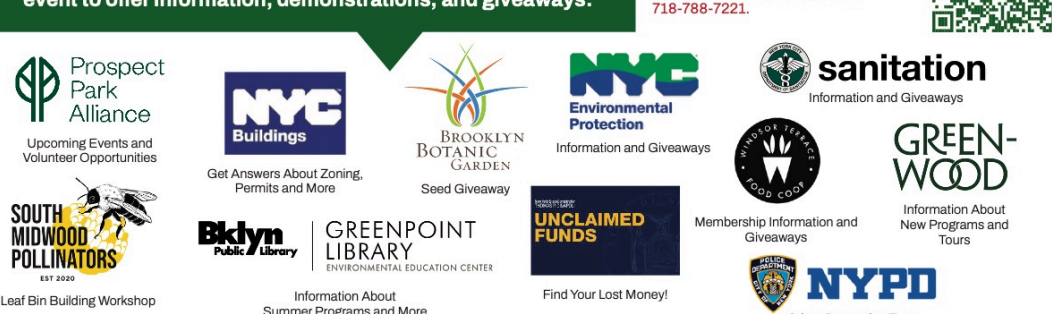
