Dear Community Resident:

Each year, as required by the New York City Charter, all 59 NYC Community Boards submit recommendations for NYC's capital and expense budgets for the upcoming fiscal year.

*Community members are invited to participate in the budget process by suggesting **a new city service or capital project.***

Please note that capital projects generally have a value of \$35,000 or more and have a useful life of at least 5 years. Recommendations can be made for new city services but please note that requests regarding existing programs and regular city services (e.g., street signs, building inspections, parks maintenance, road repair, tree pruning) should be directed to the Community Board office as routine service delivery requests.

Recommendations from the community must be received by CB14 no later than **Friday, September 4, 2026** to be considered at Community Board 14's public hearing on community budget recommendations for fiscal year 2028. This hearing will take place on **Monday, September 14, 2026, at 6:45 PM**, in person at the East Midwood Jewish Center at 1625 Ocean Avenue. - 3. Repair or upgrade subway stations, including accessibility improvements and an elevator at the Avenue M station of the MTA Q subway line
- 4. Provide area-wide studies for major thoroughfares
- 5. Improve street lighting, including more expeditious repair of outages and installation of additional lights
- 6. Improve public engagement in Brooklyn, including response time to complaints, reports, and requests
