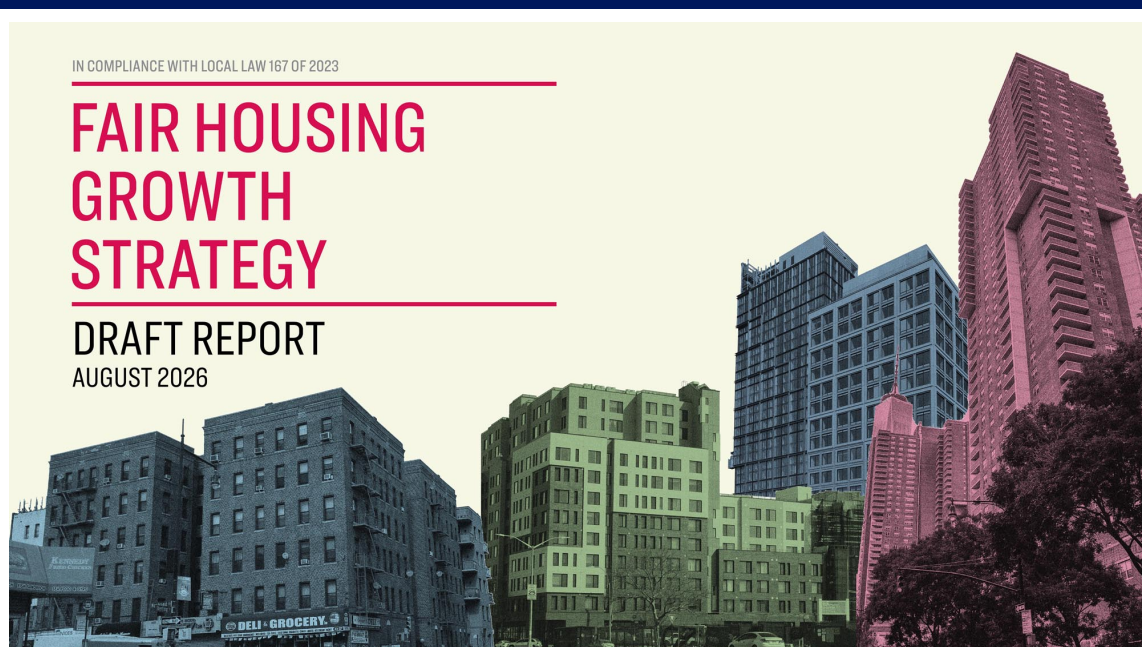

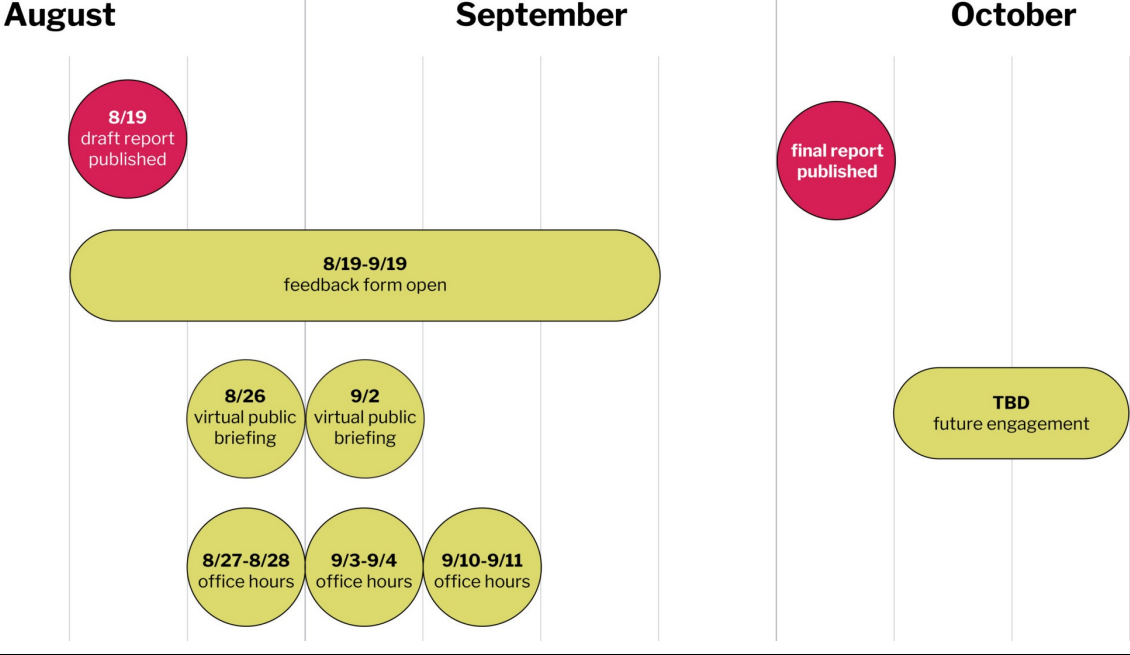
DRAFT FAIR HOUSING GROWTH STRATEGY OPEN FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

This summer, New York City released the draft Fair Housing Growth Strategy for public review and comment. Required under Local Law 167 of 2023, the strategy evaluates the city's housing needs and provides a citywide vision for more equitable housing production.

The strategy is part of the City’s Fair Housing Framework, which also includes Where We Live NYC, its comprehensive fair housing plan.

Feedback will be accepted from August 19 through September 19, 2026. New Yorkers can review the draft and provide feedback by attending a virtual briefing, submitting written comments, or speaking one-on-one with a project team member.

NYC BIN REQUIREMENT ENFORCEMENT STARTS ON SEPTEMBER 8

Properties with 1–9 residential units and certain special-use buildings receiving DSNY collection are required to use the official NYC Bin for trash setout. This includes houses of worship, nonprofits, City agencies, and professional offices located in residential buildings. Failure to use a NYC Bin with a secure lid for trash setout may result in fines.

Official NYC Bins are designed to be rodent resistant and compatible with DSNY’s mechanical collection equipment. DSNY notes that demand has increased in recent weeks and supplies are being restocked daily at NYC Home Depot locations.

Reimbursement Program

A limited reimbursement program is available to help eligible residents offset the cost of purchasing an NYC Bin. **You must request your reimbursement by September 8, 2026.** Details on eligibility and how to apply are available at the link below.

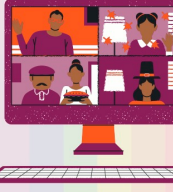
